

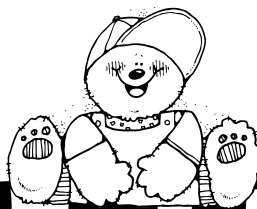
My students did this activity independently. I put paper squares in the math tub and they used their paper and glue to create the little person. They used scrapbook paper to make their person and paper scraps to create the cookies. The only rule they had was that they could not make more than 6 cookies for each side. When their cookies were finished, they used their glue bottles to create lines that we sprinkled with real sprinkles and sugar cinnamon. They wrote their number sentence on the line below the words.

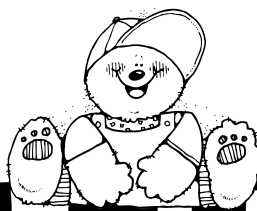
